## Last Sunday Morning...

Pastor Joseph continued the lesson on “The Temple of God” which portrays purity both inwardly and outwardly, including modesty in dress. Someone who disdains modesty will also despise true, demonstrative worship. King David’s wife, Queen Michal, arrogantly wanted her husband to be “dignified” and “solemn.” The concept of being both worshipful and kingly was foreign to her. She criticized his worship dance, and so she was left barren. Likewise, any church that will not worship God is one that will have no spiritual babies. We also began to look at biblical teachings on what we eat and drink. Several covenants were mentioned, with some difference between them noted: The Adamic Covenant, Noahic Covenant, Mosaic Covenant, and the New Covenant under Jesus have each shown dietary changes. Mark 17:15, Col. 2:16-17 (plus other verses yet to be covered), show that we are free from the ceremonial laws of diet held under the Mosaic Covenant. However, no covenant, not even ours, permits consumption of blood or meat from strangled animals (because of blood in it).

## Last Sunday Night...

The Lord moved in amazing ways Sunday evening, and almost nothing went “as usual.” There was anointed worship, including dancing, shouting, singing, and running, and many were renewed in the Holy Ghost, especially the youth and children. Eric McClain was touched mightily by the Holy Ghost, and will no doubt soon get the freedom in God’s Spirit he desires. He is diligently seeking, and God “is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him” (Hebrews 11:6). After the Lord Jesus Christ had “preached” to all so powerfully by His Spirit, Pastor Joseph felt led to ask the whole church “carry” the move of God over to the UHC hospital to pray for and minister to Bro. Jack Murphy. Thus, instead of Pastor Joseph preaching for the more of the evening, he and many of the Saints carpooled to the hospital, where a powerfully anointed prayer meeting was convened in room 554 at UHC. The next day, Monday, Bro. Murphy underwent a surgical biopsy procedure. He has since received that pathology report. God sometimes lets things get even darker before He comes and makes it lighter. Jesus said only “Lazarus, come forth”, and Lazarus was revived. We can’t question God’s timing. He is never late; He is always on time. Prayer, along with having faith in God, was greatly emphasized. Whose report shall we believe? At the conclusion of the service there were faith testimonies and we sang praises to God.

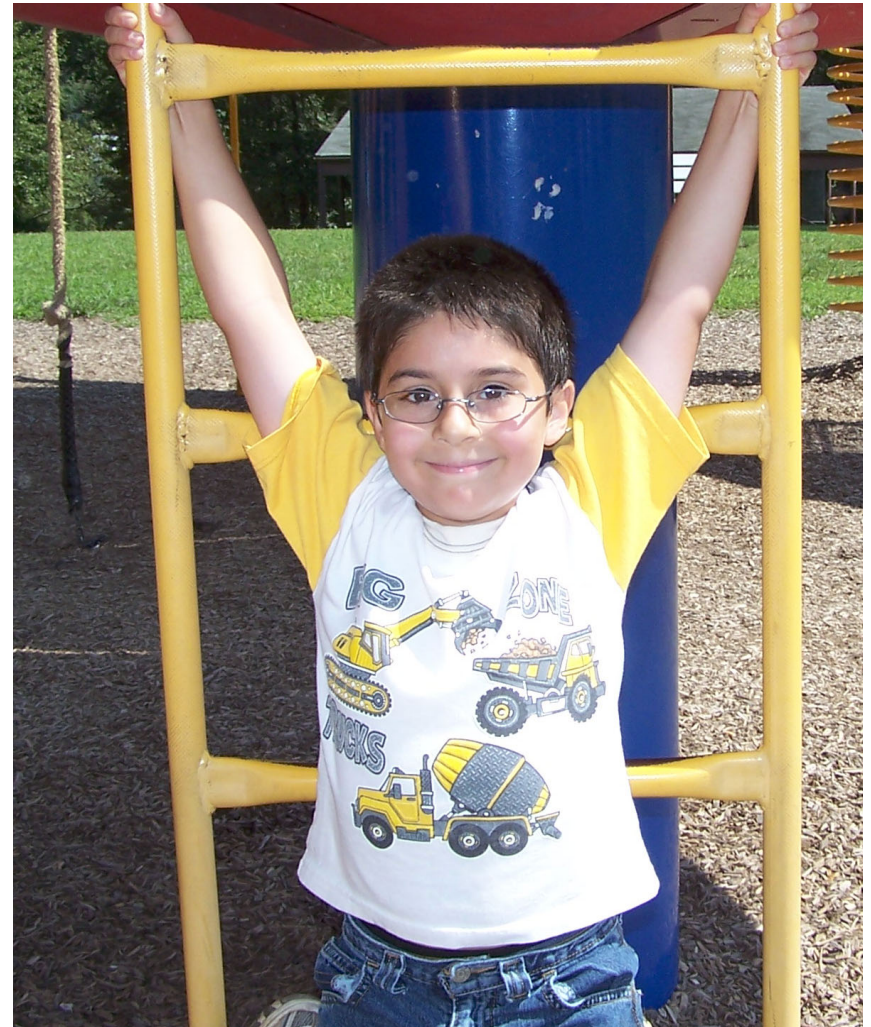
