Last Sunday Morning...

Pastor Joseph preached a message entitled "The Servant, Sword, and Flame that Guard THE WAY" drawn from the text of Genesis 3:22-24. After Adam and Eve were cast out of the Garden of Eden, the WAY back to the Tree of Life was guarded by cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth. According to Ezekiel, cherubim are servants. JESUS is the ultimate servant. JESUS is also the Word of God, which is the sword of the Spirit. He also is the fire of the Holy Ghost. He also is the WAY (He said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life..." John 14:6). He also is the Tree of Life (He said, "I am the vine, ye are the branches..." John 15:5). In every aspect of the account in Genesis 3:22-24, we see JESUS. It's all in Him. Too often, we try to "live for God" in our own strength and by our own efforts. We should rest in him, and be alive to Jesus, yet dead to sin. Living for God is "not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord." We need to let the sword kill our sinful nature, and let the fire burn our carnal nature, so we can be dead to the world and to sin and be purified and alive unto God.

Last Sunday Night...


Pastor Joseph preached using Hebrews 11:23-28 and Luke 4:14-23 as his text passages from the Bible. Do we know how we fit into God's plan? We are all a part of the Body of Christ. Each one of us has an identity with God. There are times in our life when the devil tricks us into giving up. We lose our identity with God—we don't know who we are. Don't listen to the devil. In Hebrews 11:24 we are told how Moses refused to "be called the son of Pharoah's daughter." His identity was a Hebrew. He was a man who knew God, and he would not listen when men tried to tell him who he was. The decisions we make define who we are. The devil may say to you 'you don't need to go to church tonight.' But tonight may be the very night you would receive something from God! The devil tells us that we can do what everyone else is doing. Don't listen to him. God is our spiritual Father, and the church is our spiritual Mother. We are members of the Body of Christ. Be glad and excited about who you are and where we are going! Jesus is our example!

Our guest speaker was Pastor Perry Harris from Salisbury, North Carolina. The title of his message was "Who is Jesus Christ?" He gave 16 scriptural points for the answer.
