## Last Sunday Morning...

Pastor Joseph preached, from Matthew 1:21, a message for Christmas entitled. "The Savior Has Come." The historical and etymological roots of our Savior's name were brought out. Jesus is from Jehoshua (Hebrew Yehoshua'). The root words—Yahweh (Jehovah), the personal name of God in the Old Testament, and *yasha*, meaning to help, preserve, rescue, save-were combined in our Lord's name, with the meaning "Yahweh-Savior" or "God is Salvation." This meaning explains the words of the angelic announcement: "Thou shalt call his name Jesus, for he shall save his people from their sins." It fulfills the meaning of the title *Emmanuel*, which means "God with us." God, or Jehovah, has come to be with us for the purpose of taking away our sins. Our God is our Savior (Isaiah 25:9). The Savior for whom we have waited is none other than our Lord and God. The word "salvation" in Isaiah 25:9 is from the Hebrew veshua. It means deliverance, health, help, salvation. It is from same root word as the name of Jesus. Salvation is a person: Jesus Christ! Simeon so proclaimed this, in Luke 2:29-32. Our God became our Savior! Our Savior has come! God came to dwell with us to save us from our sins. We must wait patiently for His ultimate salvation plan to be accomplished. In the meantime, we can have Him dwelling in our lives.

## Last Wednesday Night...

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr. preached "Does He Know You?" He took his text from Acts 19:11-15. "God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul." There were seven sons of Sceva, a Jew, who tried to cast out some evil spirits by the names of Jesus and Paul. But "the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?" We profess that we love and know Jesus; but do we really? How long how it been since you had a visitation with the Lord? How long has it been since you prayed and cried before the Lord? We need to daily seek the Lord and come before His presence. The Lord knows them that are His. He knows those who truly love Him. Psalms 139:1-4 tells us that the Lord knows us. He knows everything in our life. He created us. Take faith in the Lord, and strengthen your relationship with Him. Trust in Him with all your heart.
